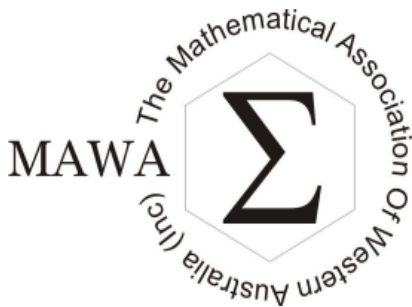

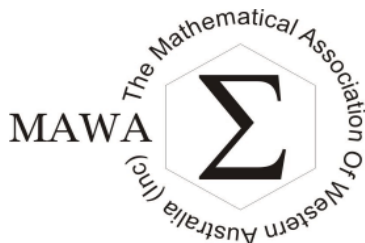

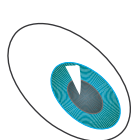

This website has been established to provide high school teachers with a bank of Working Mathematically activities focusing on a variety of rural pursuits.

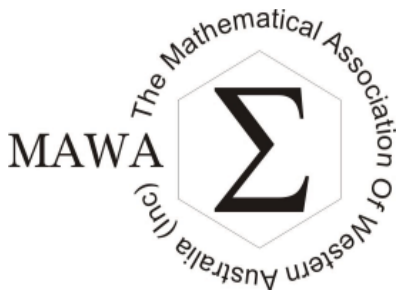

Maria Carla Palmeri is a maths teacher in Florence, Italy who's been using the dynamic geometrical program Cabri Geometry with 11-years old students; one hour a week for the whole year. The students followed teacher prepared worksheets to make many different geometrical constructions and animations, which have been used in this video to show the interesting things that can be done using Cabri Geometry.
