1. **Motion 1. Insert Item 20.4: ‘the Committee shall ensure that no less than one General Meeting per year will be held.’**

7. **Motion 7. Re-number ‘Office Bearers’ as Item 35, 35.1 & 35.2** *Proposed N Reynolds/Seconded P Swan*
8. **Motion 8. Re-number ‘Committee’ as Item 36, 36.1, 36.2, 36.3, 36.4, 36.5, 36.6, 36.7, 36.8, 36.9, 36.10** *Proposed N Reynolds/Seconded P Swan*
