Anne Lawrence



Anne Lawrence (BSc, DipTchg, MEdStuds) is the Team Leader for the Numeracy and Mathematics advisers at the Centre for Educational Development, Massey University, New Zealand. Prior to taking up this position, Anne taught at an urban coeducational school where she was Head of Mathematics. As an adviser, Anne works with mathematics teachers in a wide range of schools. A major component of her role over the past four years has been to support teachers implementing the Numeracy Project in New Zealand secondary schools. Anne's particular focus is on expanding the range of effective teaching strategies that mathematics teachers use. Her work with teachers and students in classrooms led to her interest in literacy within mathematics.

First Steps

Primary teachers will be able to participate in a stream which focuses around the First Steps modules. Delegates attending the First Steps modules will also be able to participate in the Friday evening session, the Keynote Address on Saturday morning and all of the informal aspects of the conference.

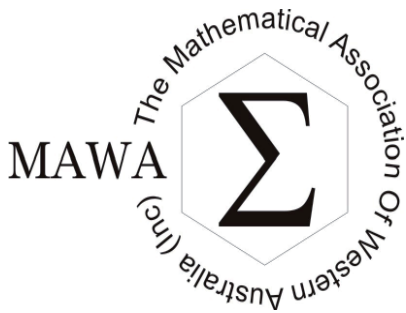

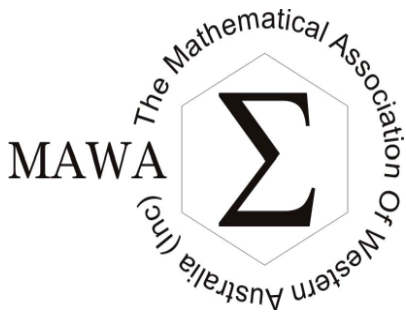

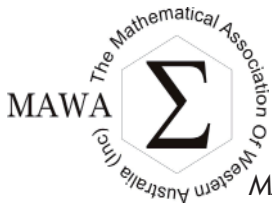
